City Hosts

Our City Hosts are capable, committed, inspirational volunteers providing public facing roles building on our proud history of volunteering since 2012 and continuing the volunteer legacy on from the UK City of Culture 2021.

The City Host role aims to enhance events, tourism, conferences and visitor experience by:

- Providing a friendly and warm welcome and farewell for all visitors, spectators, and participants.
- Wayfinding and guiding and providing assistance to visitors and event spectators.
- Promoting and providing information about the local area and event(s).
- Supporting areas of displays, artwork, installations.
- Lining borders of event areas for trails and performances.
- Hosting of event performers and special guests.
- Providing a crucial extra level of support for those with access needs and making everyone feel most welcome.
- Any other event volunteer support that is deemed suitable.

Due to the core principles and training provided the roles that are mostly undertaken involve customer service, meet & greet, registration and marshalling roles. City Hosts help to ensure your event, conference, award ceremony or visitor experience operates smoothly by being integral to the event operation and being the friendly face of your occasion.

Groups of our volunteers have undergone additional training to undertake Team Leader roles that will provide a ready-made command structure for you.

Young Volunteers

Young & Youth Ambassadors

As Coventry moves from the completion of UK City of Culture 2021 it is in a unique position to develop long term, sustainable volunteering within the city.

The Coventry Young Ambassador programme and our training began in 2018 as a pilot programme working in partnership with a select group of lead primary schools across Coventry. Since then we have developed the programme further with an increasing number of schools and local colleges.

The Young & Youth Ambassador project includes:

- Providing leadership opportunities.
- Creating the next generation of volunteers.
- Developing an increased sense of pride and belonging to the community.
- Opportunities for young people from all communities and abilities.

We continue to develop and deliver bespoke Young Ambassador training formed from our 'building blocks to being an Ambassador' including core learning activities through practical and interactive workshops.

Through a continued partnership between EnV and representatives from schools and colleges across the city we aim to provide:

- A supported pathway from Primary Schools through to 18+.
- A city volunteer programme that actively engages under-represented groups.
- Bridging the existing gap from Primary through to Secondary and Further Education event volunteering in the city.
- Providing additional experience, skills and training towards further opportunities of employment.

Welcome Walks

The Welcome Walk brings the city centre to life, highlighting key and interesting facts of city hot spots following a trail led and supported by a trained and experienced group of EnV award-winning volunteers, who have been welcoming the world to Coventry since the city hosted the London2012 Olympic Games.

The Walks are able to be arranged directly with us to suit availability and group sizes. We have worked with a variety of organisations ranging from staff teams to university student course groups, international visitors, and supporting new residents settle into their city.

The Welcome Walk is a city orientation promoting the many areas of interest on offer for visitors to return to and to spend time at for the remainder of the day or on a return visit.

Outcomes

- Raising awareness of the past, present and future of the city through welcoming, relaxed, and informative 'Welcome Walks' delivered in friendly way.
- Participants will get to know the city centre surroundings in an interactive and informative way.
- Provide a positive impression of the city that will leave visitors and residents with a greater sense of belonging. The Welcome Walks of Coventry cover various trail routes all aimed to be completed in under one hour. There is also opportunity to offer bespoke trails and take in the different and beautiful sites of Coventry.
